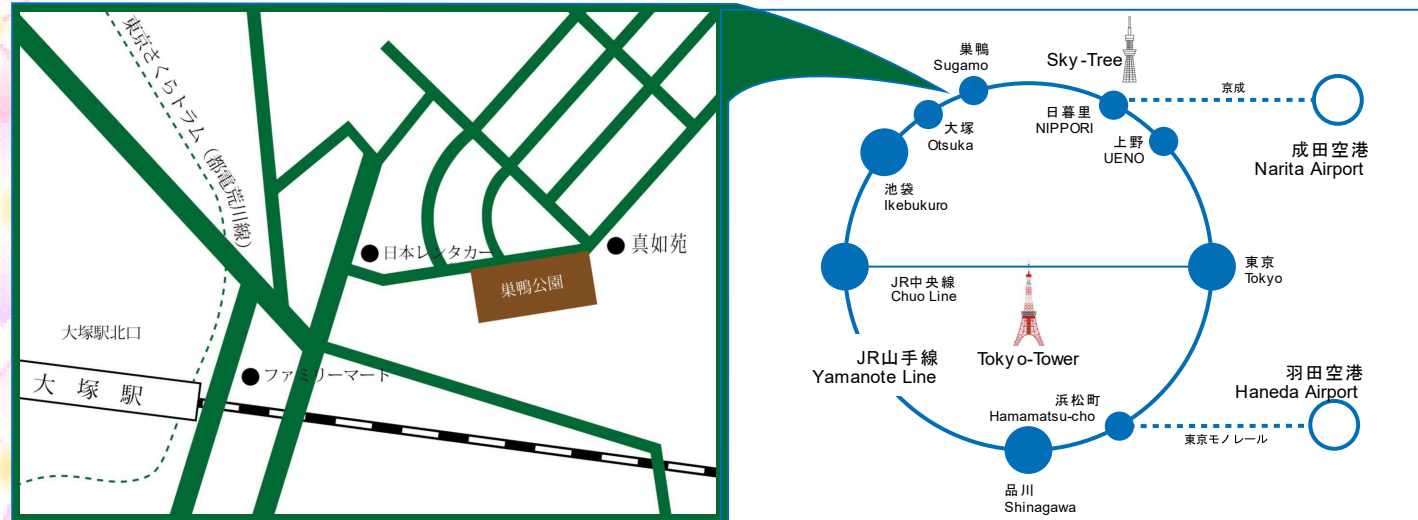

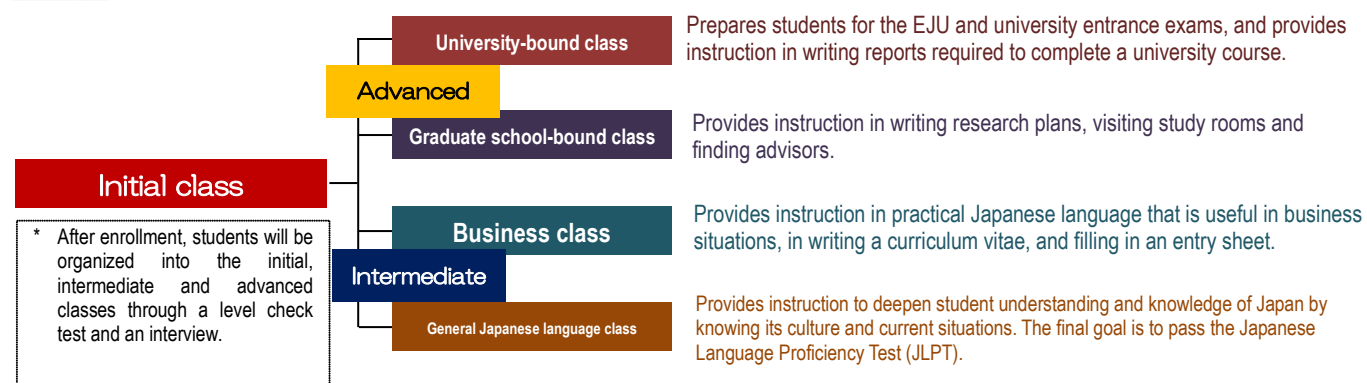

### A wide variety of optional subjects! Optional Subjects

#### English

Designed to improve academic ability by making preparations for university entrance exams as well as TOEFL and TOEIC.

#### Mathematics

Designed to prepare students to obtain high scores at the EJU. Classes analyze the differences in the study methods depending on country.

#### Chinese characters or Kanji

Designed for students from the countries where Kanji are not used and to teach Kanji by enjoying them through music and dramas. Students will also learn Kanji to expand their active vocabulary.

#### Japanese culture

Japanese anime, drama, Novel will help to students understanding of the Japanese culture and society. Moreover student can participate the four seasoning events like Hanami in spring and Japanese food in winter etc.

#### Conversation
